

DID YOU KNOW?

- Teen drivers are found at fault in 66% of ALL FATAL collisions that they are involved in, although they only represent 4% of the state's licensed drivers.
- The leading cause of **DEATH** for Americans 15 - 20 years old is motor vehicle collisions.
- 65 % of teen passenger Deaths occur when another teenager is driving.

WHAT IS THE START SMART PROGRAM?

The California Highway Patrol's Start Smart program is a FREE driver safety education class which targets new and future licensed teenage drivers between the **ages of 15 - 20** and their parents/guardians. CHP officers will discuss traffic collision avoidance techniques, collision causing factors, driver/parent responsibilities, and seatbelt usage.

Our goal is to help young drivers and their parents/guardians understand the **responsibilities associated with driving** a motor vehicle, show how a poor choice behind the wheel can change the lives of everyone involved, and to **reduce the number of teen-related injuries and deaths** due to collisions.
